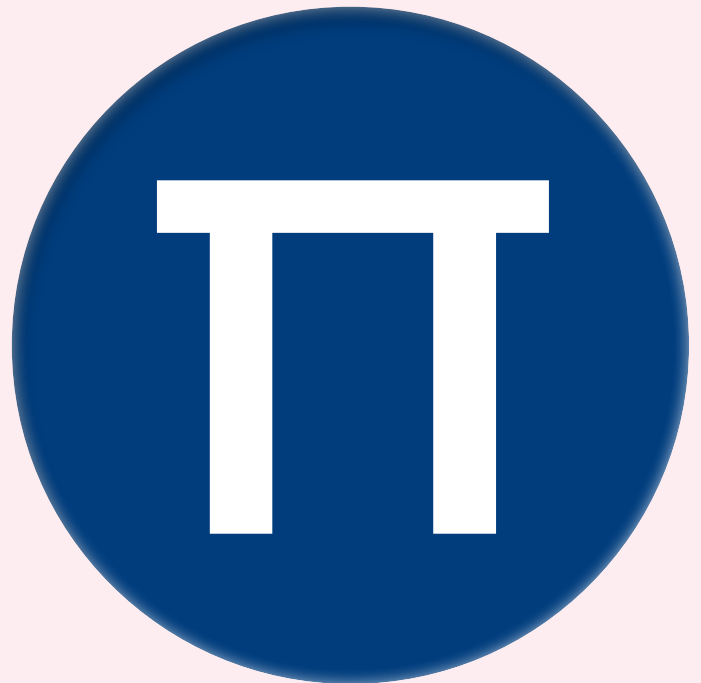
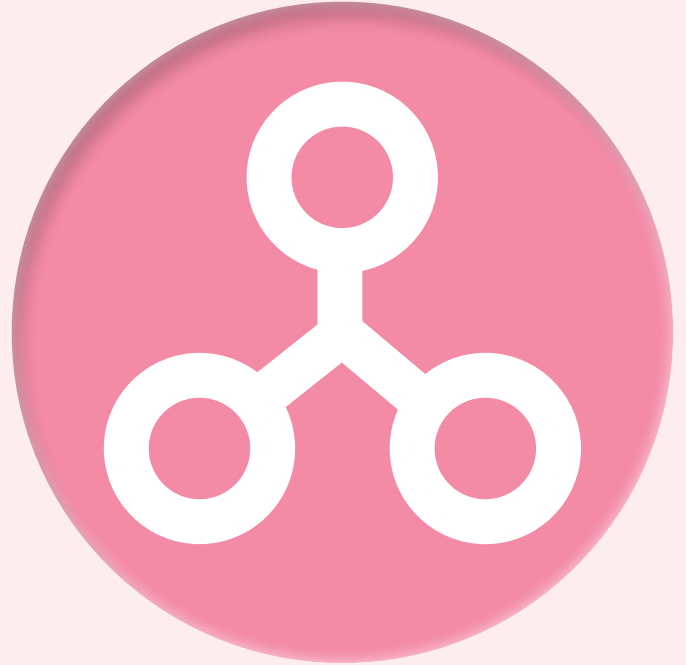

About The Stewart Family STEM Scholarship

Thank you for your interest in the Stewart Family STEM Scholarship at St Andrew's School, available to girls wishing to study at St Andrew's School in Years 4, 5 and 6, through the St Andrew's School Foundation.

This Scholarship has been generously made available by the Stewarts, a former family of St Andrew's School. Their daughter Ava showed exceptional skills and unbridled passion for all aspects of STEM. With the knowledge that females are traditionally underrepresented in the fields of science, technology, engineering and mathematics, the Stewarts wanted to make a difference to a young girl's life by offering her the opportunity to explore and enhance her interests in STEM subjects through attendance at St Andrew's School.

We welcome applications from internal and external students.

A current student on an existing scholarship at St Andrew's School is not eligible to apply.

Your Daughter's Scholarship Application

Please attach the following with the Scholarship Application:

- | The completed application form.
- | A letter to the Principal, from your daughter, explaining her interest and success in STEM subjects.
- | A copy of your daughter's latest school report.
- | Copies of any results highlighting scientific and mathematics prowess, including ICAS certificates.
- | Any further documentation to support your daughter's application.

Preparing for the Scholarship Interview

If successful through to the second stage of the process, your daughter will be invited to meet with the Principal and Mr Chris Boden, Specialist Science teacher.

To prepare for the Scholarship interview, your daughter will need to be clear and concise when asked the following questions:

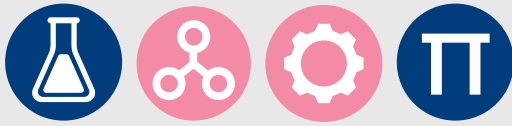
- | Why would you like to be a part of the St Andrew's School community?
- | Why do you think STEM is so important now and moving into the future?
- | Describe your passion for STEM.

The Scholarship Selection Process

After a review of the information provided and the results from the interview, a shortlist of candidates will be finalised. The Principal shall award the Scholarship offered at her absolute discretion.

The successful candidate of the Stewart Family STEM Scholarship will receive a remission of 25% of the base Tuition Fees, only, each year to the conclusion of Year 6 at St Andrew's School.

All other associated costs are payable by the recipient's parent or caregiver (please see below for further information).

Selection Agreements

The Stewart Family STEM Scholarship will be awarded based on a competitive process, designed to enable young girls to further their studies in STEM in years 4, 5 and 6 at St Andrew's School. Therefore, for reasons of fairness and equity, the Scholarship holder is expected to remain at the School until she completes Year 6.

In the event of the Scholarship holder's withdrawal prior to the end of Year 6, the full value of the Scholarship to the time of her withdrawal will be repayable to the School by the parent/guardian accepting the Scholarship on behalf of the holder.

The Principal, at her absolute discretion, may waive this obligation or fix a lesser sum as payable by the parent/guardian, if the withdrawal is due to circumstances beyond the control of the parent/guardian (e.g. parent/guardian transfer interstate or overseas).

To accept the Scholarship Offer, you will be required to:

1. Sign a Scholarship Offer Acceptance in accordance with the Selection Agreement, above.
2. Complete an Application for Enrolment Form via our website which will include a non-refundable application fee of \$130.
3. Provide a copy of your daughter's birth certificate, in accordance with established enrolment procedure, as proof of age.
4. Should your daughter not be an Australian Citizen, a copy of her current Visa is required.
5. Pay a one off, non-refundable confirmation of acceptance fee of \$825.
6. Pay a refundable Tuition Bond of \$1700, which will be refunded upon your daughter's completion of Year 6 at St Andrew's School.

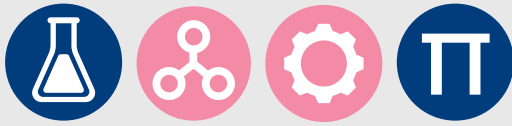
Only one form of discount applies. A student in receipt of the Scholarship is not eligible for any other discounts.

All other associated costs are NOT discounted or subsidised, i.e. fixed charge, camps, study tours, booklists, stationery and uniform and extra and co-curricular activities.

St Andrew's School can offer the Scholarship to girls on the basis of merit and equity in accordance with ATO Scholarship Guidelines.
