## Music Scholarship

We are pleased to invite applications from both current and prospective students entering Years 3 or 4 in 2027. Candidates for the Music Scholarship should have achieved a minimum level of AMEB Grade 3 or its equivalent on their main instrument.

### Key Dates and Examination Information

The registration deadline is **5:00pm on Friday 23 January 2026**. Late applications will not be accepted.

Scholarship examinations will take place at St Andrew's School on **Tuesday 3 and 10 February 2026**.

Candidates will receive confirmation of their examination time once applications have closed.

Candidates are required to prepare two contrasting pieces for their main instrument, along with one piece for their second instrument, if applicable. Candidates should bring their musical instrument(s) and organise their own accompanist if required.

## Application Process

The following supporting documentation is required:

- A letter detailing your reasons for wishing to join the St Andrew's School community
- Copies of AMEB Practical/Theory Exam Certificates or equivalent (e.g., ANZCA, Trinity London or ABRSM)
- A reference from your child's current instrumental music teacher
- Additional school references, if available

## Scholarship Details

Scholarships are awarded at the Principal's discretion and subject to availability. All decisions regarding scholarships are final, and the School will not enter into further discussion or dispute. Successful candidates may receive a remission of up to 50% of the base tuition fees each year, through to the completion of Year 6 at St Andrew's School. Please note that offers may be made for commencement in Term 3 2026 or Term 1 2027, subject to availability. Scholarship recipients are

eligible for one form of discount only and are not entitled to any additional discounts. Please refer to the Schedule of Fees and Charges available on our website.

Scholarship recipients are expected to demonstrate consistent academic excellence, a positive attitude towards learning and contribute significantly to the life of the School.

Additionally, they are required to regularly attend instrumental music lessons and ensemble rehearsals, maintain a positive attitude towards their music studies, and uphold a high standard of performance both as soloists and in ensembles. They must also participate in various performances and events organised by the Music Department throughout the year.

For successful external candidates, acceptance of the scholarship offer requires completion of the St Andrew's online enrolment form, payment of the Confirmation Fee and a Tuition Bond. This does not apply to current students.

Upon offer, external families will be invited to attend a school tour and meet with a member of our Executive Leadership Team.
