The Tarrkarri Scholarship recognises the importance of culture, connection and opportunity for First Nations students at St Andrew's. This values-based scholarship reflects our commitment to supporting First Nations students and their families as valued members of our school community.

Applications are open to prospective students entering Reception to Year 6 in 2027. Places are subject to availability.

The registration deadline is **5:00pm** on Friday 28 November 2025.
Late applications will not be accepted.
Applications will be assessed as they are received, so you are encouraged to apply as soon as possible.

Eligibility Criteria

The student, or their parent(s) or grandparent(s):

- is/are of Aboriginal or Torres Strait Islander descent
- is/are recognised in their Aboriginal or Torres Strait Islander community where they live or formerly lived as an Aboriginal or Torres Strait Islander person

regards themselves as an Aboriginal or Torres Strait Islander person

 is committed to upholding the values of St Andrew's School and engaging positively in school and community life

Scholarships are awarded at the Principal's discretion and subject to availability. All decisions regarding scholarships are final, and the School will not enter into further discussion or dispute. Successful candidates may receive a remission of up to 50% of the base tuition fees each year, through to the completion of Year 6 at St Andrew's School. Please note that the scholarship does not cover additional costs such as camps, uniforms, or ICT expenses.

Offers may be made for Term 3, 2026 or Term 1, 2027 commencement, subject to availability. Scholarship recipients are eligible for one form of discount and are not entitled to any additional discounts. Please refer to the Schedule of Fees and Charges available on our website.
